

2020 Mint 400 Race Penalties and Disqualifications

Following thorough research into each race incident, we have come to the following decisions regarding race incidents:

• Robby Gordon - Class UTV Pro NA - #1971

- Incident
 - Driving with no co-driver for a 35 mi stretch of racecourse
 - Utilizing an unregistered person in a co-driver position for 1 full lap of the race.
- Determination Driver is Disqualified from the race
 - Reason Having an unlicensed/unregistered driver in the co-driver position for 1 full lap of the race
- The incident of driving with no co-driver for a 35 mi stretch was allowed via Pit A
 Captain due to a medical emergency.
- The incident of short coursing was evaluated. It was determined that this was done by several other racers as well and is being allowed due to confusion with course markings.

• Justin Lofton - Class Unlimited Truck - #1

- Incident
 - Unsportsmanlike and dangerous conduct toward media on track
- <u>Determination</u> <u>Driver</u> is <u>Disqualified</u> from the race & is fined \$3000 (to cover property damage)
 - Reason posing an intentional danger to media staff on track, damage to photography equipment

• Heath Shoup/Brandon Villano - Class Baja Truck - #232

- Incident
 - Danger to safety crew. Failure to avoid contact with vehicle in tow by safety personnel.
- Determination Driver is moved to the back of the 4 lap finishers for his class. This moves the driver from 13th position to 14th position.
 - Reason failure to yield to on-track safety personnel, posing a danger to on-track safety crew.
